Additional Grant Opportunity

The Nonpoint Source (NPS) Program is issuing an announcement of Additional Grant Opportunity (AGO) for proposals that focus on nonpoint source water pollution. The amount available is approximately \$80,000. We are accepting one or two year proposals. You must submit your initial proposal using our online form, which can be found at: <https://dep.wv.gov/WWE/Programs/nonptsourcesubmit/Pages/LOI.aspx>.

The project submittals will be reviewed by the NPS Team. We will ask for a formal proposal from those projects that best fit the goals and objectives of the NPS Program. If your project is chosen you will be notified by E-mail. Formal project proposals (work plans) are required within **30 days** of notification.
