


Sleepy Creek Watershed Morgan & Berkeley Counties, WV

- Empties into Potomac River
- Flows north from Frederick Co., VA
- 145 square mile drainage area
 - \Rightarrow 125 square miles located in WV
- 77% of WV watershed is forested
- Impaired for fecal coliform bacteria
- TMDL developed in 2008
- WBP approved in 2008; updated WBP under review
- Major tributary Indian Run also impaired for FCB; delisted in 2012

Project Highlights

- Failing septic system repair (72 systems)
- Urban tree plantings (18.77 ac)
- Porous pavers (0.76 ac)
- Septic system pumping (213 systems) Bioretention (7.38 ac)
 - Water monitoring & molecular source tracking of bacteria

- 1.96E+14 CFU/year fecal coliform bacteria
- 168.69 lbs/year nitrogen
- 54.48 lbs/year phosphorus
- 81.48 tons/year sediment
