WATER PROVIDERS

Instructions for Completing the Large Quantity User Registration Forms

This form is for facilities that withdraw water for distribution to their customers. If you only use the water at your business, do not use this form. Businesses and industrial users must use the **Industrial User** form.

Complete all fields on the form. You may download the Microsoft Word version to use on a computer, or print the .pdf version if you wish to complete the form by hand. Mail your completed form to:

Some fields are self-explanatory, so instructions are omitted for them. However, you must **complete all fields**. Please do <u>NOT</u> use the word "SAME" in any of your responses. If you are not able to provide the information, write "NONE" or "N/A" in the response box. For example, if you only have a street mailing address, such as "223 Smith Lane", use it to complete question **2**) Facility Mailing Address 1; for line **3**) Facility Mailing Address 2, enter "NONE".

<u>SECTION ONE – GENERAL INFORMATION</u>

- 1. **Facility Name**: If you completed the water use survey, you are a registered user. If the name changes, please note the old and new names on the form.
- 7. **Facility E-Mail (if Available)**: If your facility has an e-mail address, such as *ABC_Shoes @klunkmail.com*, which is checked by a facility employee, enter it here.
- 10. **Facility SIC Code**: This is the Standard Industrial Code for your business. If you don't know your code, you can determine it at this web site: http://www.sec.gov/info/edgar/siccodes.htm
- 11. **Facility NAICS Code**: This is the North American Industrial Classification System code. You may find your code at: <u>http://www.naics.com/search/</u>
- 13. Facility FEIN: This is the Federal Employer Identification Number. Obtain it from your accounting department.
- 14 -- 19. **Facility Physical Address**: These refer to the actual physical location of your facility. Complete these boxes even if the mailing address and the physical address is the same.

- 29 32. **Contact Information**: Supply this information for the person who can respond to questions about the survey. The person should have knowledge of how the water was measured, how the location information was determined, etc.
- 34. Do you have any water purchased from a provider?: If you purchase water from another provider, complete these questions. You must also complete the *PURCHASED WATER FORM* for each provider in <u>SECTION II</u>.

<u>SECTION II – WATER WITHDRAWALS</u>

You must complete one of these forms for each discreet withdrawal point. Surface water and groundwater are on different forms.

Decimal Latitude and Longitude: Carried out to at least seven decimal places. Most GPS systems can be set to provide readings in a decimal format. If the data you have is in degrees, minutes, seconds, you may convert it to decimal format at: <u>http://www.fcc.gov/mb/audio/bickel/DDDMMSS-decimal.html</u>

How was location determined?: Was it from a survey, a topographic map, a GPS unit, etc. If it was from a GPS unit, please give the make and model number of the unit.

Water Source Name: Such as: Elk River, or Sutton Lake, etc.

<u>Water Source Type</u>: pond, river, ground water well, etc.
