

DEP to Hold Public Meeting

The West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Air Quality (DAQ), pursuant to §45-13-9, will hold a public meeting on Tuesday, July 30, to provide information and receive comments regarding Domestic Synthetic Fuels I, LLC's air quality permit application. Domestic Synthetic Fuels I has proposed the construction of a direct coal liquefaction facility to be located in the Mason County Industrial Park, approximately 5.8 miles north of downtown Point Pleasant, Mason County, at latitude 38.92554 and longitude -82.10807.

The public meeting will be held at the Mason County Courthouse, 200 Sixth Street, Point Pleasant, at 6 p.m. Representatives from the DAQ will conduct the meeting regarding the construction application originally submitted by Domestic Synthetic Fuels I on January 15, 2019, and resubmitted on May 10, 2019.
