This cleanup is project oriented (refer to the information on the next page of this application to determine what types of projects qualify for assistance) and can take place any time from April 1, 2020 until April 15, 2020. Projects must be approved by our office before a group can receive assistance. The registration deadline is March 1, 2020.



2020 WV MAKE IT SHINE STATEWIDE CLEANUP INFORMATION

In order to receive assistance with your cleanup, prior approval for the project must be given by the WV Make It Shine Program.

Attention: Groups or individuals conducting unapproved cleanups will be solely responsible for the removal and disposal of waste collected.

The following types of projects qualify:

- · River/stream cleanups
- Lake cleanups
- · Illegal dump cleanups
- Park cleanups
- Playground cleanups
- Public cemetery cleanups
- School ground cleanups
- · Miscellaneous cleanups with prior approval

The following types of projects DO NOT qualify:

- · Community dump days
- Drop off sites
- Household garbage collection
- · Cleanups of private property
- · Adopt-A-Highway adopted roadways

Assistance available:

- Trash bags, gloves and disposal fees paid by the DEP's PPOD program
- One day (8 hours) per dump truck, per county of hauling to the landfill
- Public relations and press assistance

Things to remember when planning your project:

- Disposal fees will be paid directly to the landfill and only for the waste that results from the one-day cleanup project.
- The waste will be hauled to a proper location at the hauler's discretion.
- Cleanup participants are encouraged to recycle; <u>however, you must arrange for the disposal of any</u> <u>recyclables collected.</u>
