RE: FY2022 Priority List for the Clean Water State Revolving Fund Program

The Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) Program is beginning preparation of the FY2022 Priority List. If you wish to be listed on the FY2022 CWSRF priority list, you must submit an application. The attached priority list application must be completed and returned no later than January 15, 2021, if a CWSRF loan closing is anticipated for the project during state fiscal year 2022. This application can also be found on the www.dep.wv.gov website under Water and Waste, Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) Program documents and publications or directly at www.dep.wv.gov/WWE/programs/SRF.

The FY2022 Priority List will contain applicants eligible to be considered for a loan agreement between July 1, 2021 and June 30, 2022. All information requested on this document must be provided. Please note that the last page of the priority list application needs to be completed **only** if you have a project that you feel meets the requirements to be qualified as a “green project”. If you wish to be considered as an eligible green reserve project, then you must complete this portion of the application.
