Additional Grant Opportunity

The Nonpoint Source (NPS) Program is issuing an announcement of Additional Grant Opportunity (AGO) for proposals that focus on nonpoint source water pollution. The amount available is \$95,811. We are accepting one or two year proposals, which should range from \$2,000 - \$20,000. You must submit your letter of intent (LOI) using the LOI portal, which is found at the link below.

The project submittals will be reviewed by the NPS Team. We will ask for a formal proposal from those projects that best fit the goals and objectives of the NPS Program. If your project is chosen, you will be notified by email. Formal project proposals (workplans) are required within **15-30 days** of notification.
