
How to Claim an Aboveground Storage Tank During an Ownership Transfer

Creating a Registration Modification Applications to Claim ASTs as Part of a Transfer Of Ownership




The New Application creation window will appear.


- a. <u>Application Type</u> –
 Select AST Registration
 Modification as the application type.
- Application Name –
 Fill in an application name. The name is created by the tank owner and can later be used to search for the application on the "My Applications" screen.
- c. Owner –
 Select the Owner. You may
 have user right to register
 tanks for multiple owners.
 Ensure you are selecting the
 intended owner.
- d. Choose the permit that you would like to transfer the tanks to.
- e. <u>Click "OK"</u> to create the application.




The "My Applications" button can later be used to locate for previously created applications by searching for the owner assigned application name.



Once the application has been created, you will now see the below tabs/section. Click on the "claim tank from previous owner" link. NOTE: you may need to fill out some information in other sections. A red asterix indicates missing information.






The tank(s) should now appear in the tank list on the modification form. Click on the tank name and fill out any information that is missing. Once the application status is complete, click on the certification tab. Use the modification application guidance for assistance in filling out tank information.
