
Accessing Your Facility Management Plan

The compliance activities listed below for your federally regulated underground storage tanks are required by West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection (WVDEP) and federal UST regulations (40 CFR Part 280) are based on the tank registration information that was submitted to WV DEP and/or data recorded by WV DEP at the last on-site inspection. Incorrect information in this plan does not relieve the tank owner and/or operator for maintaining full compliance with the UST regulations.

The compliance activities listed below are specific to this facility and should help you plan the work that needs to be completed. In many cases, a WVDEP Certified Worker will be required to perform repairs and testing. Any topic areas in this compliance plan that are in red may indicate a compliance issue and/or insufficient information to provide specific information on what you are required to complete to comply with the regulations.
