Dear Mr. Kimmel:

It has been determined that your proposed changes to the North Plant located in the Morgantown Industrial Park are not defined, pursuant to §45-13-2.17, as a “modification.” This determination is based on the information (including your emissions calculations) in your Permit Determination Form (PDF) submitted on July 24, 2017 that indicates that the changes do not have a reasonably calculated maximum potential to increase emissions over two (2) lbs/hr OR five (5) tons/year of total Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAPs); six (6) lbs/hour AND ten (10) TPY or one hundred forty-four (144) pounds per calendar day of any regulated pollutant; or *trigger* a substantive requirement of any State or Federal air quality regulation.

Please be aware that any future changes to the facility (or substantive changes to the Weston 430 Zero Phenol (W430ZP) production process as described in your PDF) may trigger the requirement to obtain a permit if the changes are defined as a “modification” under 45CSR13.
