**Subject:** Class I Administrative Update of R13-3113A (R13-3113B) Williams Ohio Valley Midstream LLC – Goshorn Dehydration Station (051-00172)

On April 12, 2017, the DAQ received a request from Williams Ohio Valley Midstream LLC (Williams) to update Permit R13-3113A. This request is to allow the flexibility of having up to two glycol pumps (one pump solely used as a backup) hooked up at their dehydration sites (only one pump will be allowed to operate at a time) in their Cameron Gathering District.

The proposed changes will not result in an increase in permitted emissions.

The change in requirements are considered to be equivalent or superior to the existing permit requirements as the current permit does not contain any requirements or limitations on the glycol pump(s).

The proposed changes meet the criteria of Class I Administrative Update under 45 CSR §13-4.2.a. Williams included a complete application in their administrative update request. Therefore, the writer recommends to the Director to grant Williams their request by issuing Permit R13-3113B for their Goshorn Dehydration Station located near Goshorn Ridge Road, WV.
