

What is a Title V Permit?



Title V Operating Permit

Facility Description

ROXUL USA Inc. operates a mineral wool insulation manufacturing facility at the former Jefferson Orchards site in Ranson, Jefferson County, West Virginia.

The RAN Facility manufactures stone wool insulation (SIC - 3296) for building insulation, customized solutions for industrial applications, acoustic ceilings, and other applications.

Summary of DAQ Review

- ROXUL USA Inc. Initial Title V Application Received: May 20, 2022
- Title V Permit was put on hold until R14-0037A was issued:
 - R14-0037A Application Originally Submitted: October 3, 2022
 - R14-0037A Application resubmitted as a modification to a minor source on May 22, 2023
 - R14-0037A issued November 16, 2023
 - R14-0037A was appealed by both ROXUL USA Inc. on December 11, 2023 and Jefferson County Foundation on December 18, 2023.
 - The Air Quality Board's Ruling on ROXUL USA Inc.'s appeal is still pending.
 - Jefferson County Foundation's appeal was dismissed on February 7, 2024.
- Initial Title V Application resubmitted on January 17, 2024.
- DAQ published Class I legal notice for the Draft/Proposed Initial Title V Permit R30-03700108-2024 on May 22, 2024.
- DAQ received a request for a Public Hearing on June 7, 2024.
- DAQ published Class I legal notice for the Draft Title V Permit R30-03700108-2024 and Virtual Public Hearing on June 19, 2024.

Differences Between R14-0037A and R30-03700108-2024

- R14-0037A incorporates by reference the applicable requirements of:
 - 40 C.F.R. 60 Subpart OOO
 - 40 C.F.R. 60 Subpart IIII
 - 40 C.F.R. 63 Subpart DDD
 - 40 C.F.R. 63 Subpart JJJJ
 - 40 C.F.R. 63 Subpart DDDDD
- The Title V Permit includes the entire text of these applicable requirements.
- Conditions that were appealed are noted in the Title V Permit.

WVDAQ Documents

Title V Fact Sheet

 Rationale document providing determinations and justifications on the applicability of State Rules and Federal Regulations.

Draft Permit

Includes all applicable requirements from R14-0037A,
 State Rules, and Federal Regulations.

What Happens Next?

- Comment period scheduled to conclude at 5:00 pm on Friday, August 2, 2024.
- DAQ will evaluate and respond to timely comments that are relevant to the Title V permit.
- DAQ will then send the Proposed Permit, Factsheet and Response to Comments to EPA review.
- After EPA's review of the Proposed Permit has concluded and any issues raise are addressed, DAQ will take final action.

Summary

- ROXUL USA Inc. has applied for a Permit to Operate a mineral wool production facility in Jefferson County.
- Fact Sheet and Draft Permit have been available for review since publication of the first Public Notice (May 22, 2024). A second Public Notice was published on June 19, 2024 for the Draft Permit and Public Hearing.
- DAQ will continue to accept public comments until 5:00 pm on Friday, August 2, 2024.
- DAQ will evaluate and respond to all timely submitted comments related to the Title V Permit.
- DAQ will then send the Proposed Permit, Factsheet and Response to Comments to EPA for review.
