2019 Proposed Legislative Rules

The West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection (DEP), Division of Air Quality (DAQ) has scheduled a public hearing for its 2019 proposed legislative rules on Tuesday, July 10, 2018 at the DEP Charleston headquarters located at 601 57th Street S.E., Charleston, WV 25304. The public hearing will begin at 6:00 p.m. in the Dolly Sods Conference Room #1125.

Oral and written comments will be made part of the rulemaking record. The public comment period begins on June 8, 2018 and ends at the conclusion of the public hearing. Written comments may be submitted at any time during the public comment period to the Public Information Office at the DEP address above or e-mailed to dep.comments@wv.gov.

Upon authorization and promulgation, 45CSR16, 45CSR25, and 45CSR34 will be submitted to the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to fulfill federal obligations under the Clean Air Act (CAA), including delegations and authorizations. Upon authorization and promulgation, 45CSR8 and 45CSR43 will be submitted to the EPA as a revision to the State Implementation Plan pursuant to the federal CAA. 45CSR36 and 45CSR38 are proposed for repeal because they are no longer needed.
