Recycling Interview Sample Questions

Ask the person you are interviewing to define what recycling means to them?

Was the person you are interviewing taught about recycling when they were younger?

If they recycle, why do they do it? Where did they learn to recycle? If they don't recycle, why not?

Do they recycle at their workplace? If yes, what do they do? If they don't recycle at work, what are some ideas they might have to start recycling there?

Would the person you are interviewing say that over the course of their lifetime, have they seen a trend for people to reuse and recycle more, or have they seen a trend for people to reuse and recycle less? What might be some reasons why?

How do they recycle around the house? How did their parents or grandparents recycle?

Does the person you are interviewing know how to repair furniture, electronics, clothing, or other things around the house? If so, how did they learn to do these things? If so, what is the reason they do it? Is it a hobby, to save money, because they care about the environment, or maybe another reason?
