To receive assistance with your cleanup, prior approval for the project must be given by the WV Make It Shine Program

Attention: Groups of individuals conducting unapproved cleanups will be solely responsible for the removal and disposal of waste collected.

Free Participation Gifts:

The Make It Shine program will be offering a free gift to all volunteers that participate in the 2020 statewide cleanup. Gifts will be mailed in May to the address provided on the application sheet. The following will be required for participants to receive their gift:

- Participate in the event described on the application
- Must sign the approved sign-in sheet
- Signatures must be verified and approved by project leader (via initials)
- Sign-in sheet and a complete report must be submitted to the Make it Shine Program

The following types of projects qualify:

- River/stream cleanups
- Lake cleanups
- Illegal dump cleanups
- Park cleanups
- Playground cleanups
- Public cemetery cleanups
- School ground cleanups
- Miscellaneous cleanups with prior approval

The following projects DO NOT qualify:

- Community dump days
- Drop of sites
- Household garbage collection
- Cleanups of private property
- Adopt-A-Highway roadways

Assistance available:

- Trash bags, gloves and disposal fee paid by DEP's PPOD program
- One day (8 hours) per dump truck, per county of hauling to the landfill
- Public relations and press assistance

Things to remember when planning your project:

- Disposal fees will be paid directly to the landfill and only for the waste that results from the one-day cleanup project.
The waste will be hauled to a proper location at the hauler's discretion.
- Cleanup participants are encouraged to recycle; however, you must arrange for the disposal of any recyclables collected.
