2023 WV MAKE IT SHINE STATEWIDE CLEANUP INFORMATION

To receive assistance with your cleanup, prior approval for the project **must** be given by the WV Make It Shine Program.

Attention: Groups or individuals conducting unapproved cleanups will be solely responsible for the removal and disposal of waste collected.

The following types of projects qualify:

- River/stream cleanups
- Lake cleanups
- Illegal dump cleanups
- Park cleanups
- Playground cleanups
- Public cemetery cleanups
- Schoolground cleanups
- Miscellaneous cleanups with prior approval

The following types of projects DO NOT qualify:

- Community dump days
- Drop off sites
- Household garbage collection
- Cleanups of private property
- **Roadside cleanups and cleanups of Adopt-A-Highway adopted roadways. For information concerning roadside cleanups, contact WV Adopt-A-Highway at (800)322-5530.**

Assistance available:

- Trash bags, gloves and disposal fees paid by the DEP's PPOD program
- Hauling of trash/tires by REAP to the local landfill
- Technical assistance in planning and execution of your project
- Public relations and press assistance

Things to remember when planning your project:

- Disposal fees will be paid directly to the landfill and only for the waste that results from the one-day cleanup project.
