What Oil and Gas Related Construction Activities are not covered under this permit?

1. Operations that result in the disturbance of less than one acre of total land area, which are not part of a larger common plan of development.

2. Stormwater discharges associated with land disturbing activities that may reasonably be expected to be causing or contributing to a violation of a water quality standard as determined by the Director.

3. Activities regulated under the Department of Environmental Protection Office of Oil and Gas.

4. Activities covered under the WV NPDES Stormwater Construction General Permit.

Two Types of Applications

1. Notice of Intent (NOI) Permits – short form

2. Site Registration Application Form- long form

Notice of Intent (NOI)

Projects that will:

- Disturb 1 acre to less than 3 acres
- Do not discharge to or upstream of a Tier 3 water
- Grading will last less than 1 year

Notice of Intent (NOI)

- Stormwater pollution prevention plan (SWPPP) is prepared <u>but not submitted</u> for review
- Approximate 10 day processing time
- Project shall not be started until the approval notice is received by the applicant

Site Registration Application

Projects that will:

Disturb 3 acres or more of land

or

Discharge to or upstream of a Tier 3 water

or

Grading will last 1 year or longer

Site Registration Application

- Stormwater pollution prevention plan (SWPPP) is submitted for review
- 45 days for review
- Project shall not be started until the applicant receives the approval notice

Projects Requiring Public Notice

100 acres or more of disturbance

or


 Continuous land grading phase lasting 1 year or longer


or

Projects that discharge directly to Tier 3 waters

Tier 3 Waters (47CSR2)

 all streams and rivers within the boundaries of Wilderness Areas designated by The Wilderness Act (16 U.S.C. §1131 et seq.) within the State, all Federally designated rivers under the "Wild and Scenic Rivers Act", 16 U.S.C. §1271 et seq.; all streams and other bodies of water in state parks which are high quality waters or naturally reproducing trout streams; waters in national parks and forests which are high quality waters or naturally reproducing trout streams; waters designated under the "National Parks and Recreation Act of 1978", as amended





Antidegradation Direct Discharges to a Tier 3 Segment

- SWPPP submitted for review and approval
- Advanced BMPs required
- Emphasis on stream corridor protection
- Public notice and comment period required

Antidegradation Direct Discharges Upstream of a Tier 3 Segment

- SWPPP submitted for review and approval
- Advanced BMPs may be required in some cases
- Emphasis on stream corridor protection
- No Public notice and comment period

3 < 100 ac.	Tiers 1 & 2	< 1 yr.	SWPPP submitted for review and approval Standard BMPs Low-impact development encouraged Emphasis on stream corridor protection
<u>></u> 1 ac.	Tiers 1 & 2	<u>≥</u> 1 yr.	SWPPP submitted for review and approval Standard BMPs Low-impact development encouraged Emphasis on stream corridor protection Public notice and comment period

Project Size	Protection Level	Grading Duration	Antidegradation Requirements
≥ 100 ac.	Tiers 1 & 2	any	SWPPP submitted for review and approval Standard BMPs Low-impact development encouraged Emphasis on stream corridor protection Public notice and comment period
<u>></u> 1 ac.	Tier 1 & 2 Upstream of a Tier 3	any	SWPPP submitted for review and approval Reviewer will use best professional judgment in requiring advanced BMPs Low-impact development encouraged Emphasis on stream corridor protection Public notice and comment period for sites where grading duration ≥ 1 yr. or projet size ≥ 100 ac.
<u>></u> 1 ac.	Tier 3	any	SWPPP submitted for review and approval Advanced BMPs required Low-impact development encouraged Emphasis on stream corridor protection Public notice and comment period

Posting of a Sign

 Within 24 hour of filing a NOI or Site Registration Application with DWWM, all projects shall display a sign for the duration of the construction project near the entrance of the project containing certain information.

- 1. Registrant's name
- 2. Brief description of project
- 3. Indication whether it is an NOI or SWPPP filed at DWWM
- 4. Address and telephone number of Agency
- 5. Indicate that any person may obtain a copy of the NOI or SWPPP by contacting DWWM
